“HATS ON!” AT HOLY ROSARY FROM SEPTEMBER 1

At Holy Rosary, our SunSmart Policy notes that all children will be required to wear school broad brimmed hats from ‘Hats On Day’- September 1 to ‘Hats Off Day’ - May 1, whenever they are outside including sports lessons. However, if the UV is 3 or above it is recommended hats be worn for protection. Children without hats will be required to remain under cover near the Grade 1 rooms. – ‘NO HAT, NO PLAY’ policy will be enforced.

PRINCIPAL’S REPORT

We're Back! After such an extended period of remote learning I know everyone is excited to be returning to face to face teaching for Term 4. We will continue to have the ongoing additional cleaning and hygiene practises and unfortunately parents are unable to come on site. In a slight change we ask that parents picking their children up in the drive through remain in the car to ensure it functions effectively.

Term 4 means Sunsmart and wearing hats, please ensure children have a school hat and a drink bottle to ensure they are hydrated. We will transition to full summer uniform over the next few weeks and expect everyone to be in full summer uniform by the 23rd October. The Uniform shop is open for orders via Flexi Schools and we expect to be able to fill orders reasonably quickly.

Term 4 usually has many different events scheduled, including graduations and transitions. At this stage we are still awaiting advice on the protocols for these and will communicate them as soon as practical. With the circumstances changing rapidly we look forward to information sooner rather than later. A reminder that we need all computers returned to be cleaned and reset as we return to classrooms and face to face teaching. Again if you have any questions, queries or concerns, please feel free to contact your child's classroom teacher. We look forward to working together to finish this school year in a positive way.

2021 Preparations

Term 4 is indeed a busy one, we will be beginning the process of developing class lists for 2021 which is a huge job. Parents who may have requests are asked to put these in writing by the end of October. A request does not guarantee placement, however we endeavour to do our best, with many variables to consider. I will provide the written requests to classroom teachers who complete the process. We will have some staff changes and of course changes to class structure.

Our Lady of the Rosary Feast Day

This Wednesday October 7th is the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, our School's Feast Day. Known for several centuries by the alternate title of "Our Lady of Victory," the feast day takes place in honour of a 16th century naval victory which secured Europe against Turkish invasion. Pope St. Pius V attributed the victory to the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, who was invoked on the day of the battle through a campaign to pray the Rosary throughout Europe. Pope Leo XIII was particularly devoted to Our Lady of the Rosary, producing 11 encyclicals on the subject of this feast and its importance in the course of his long pontificate. This week we will have some special activities for the children to celebrate in our house groups.

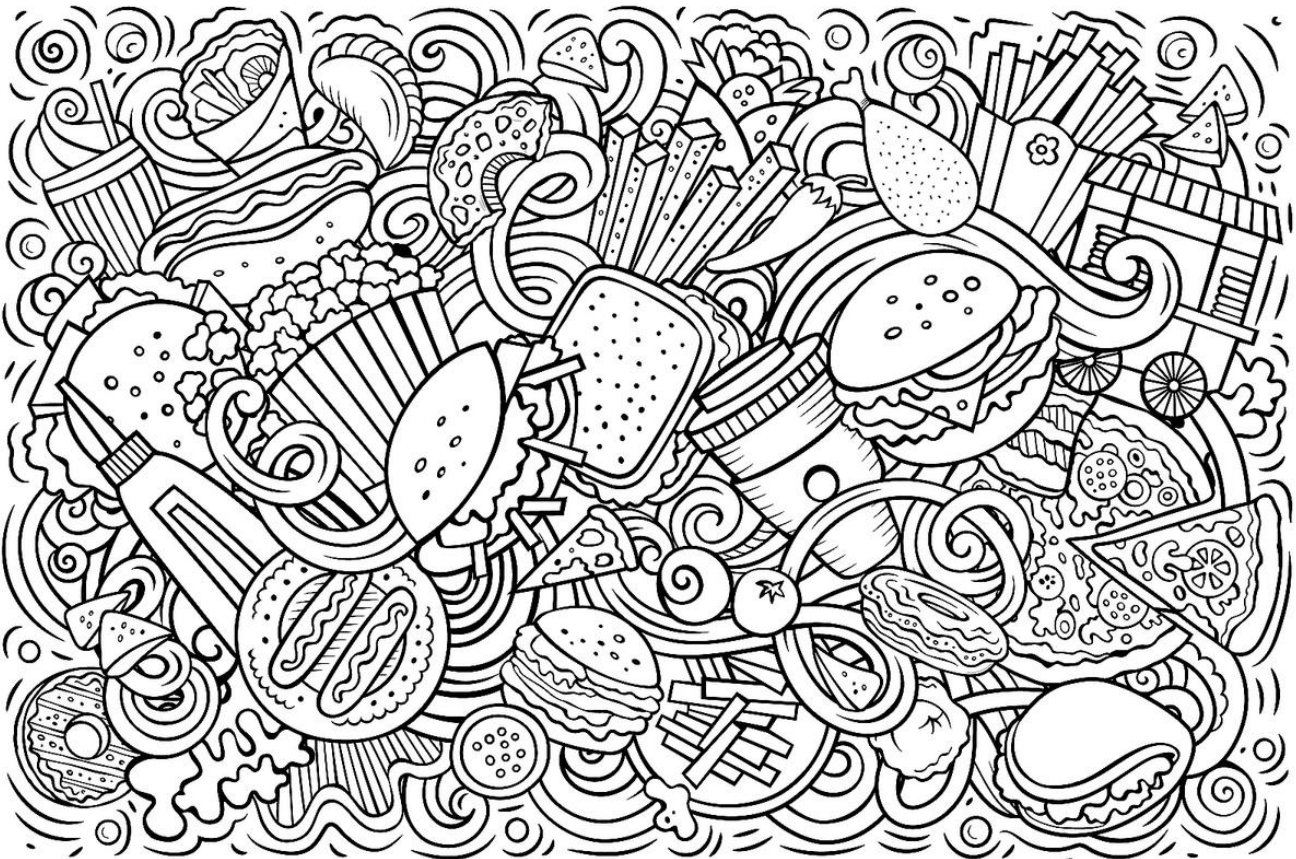
CANTEEN

What does it cost?

Online Ordering & Account Top Up Fees -

- Visa Debit and Prepaid – \$0.05 + 0.7% of the payment amount
- Visa Credit (and other Visa card types) – \$0.05 + 0.7% of the payment amount
- Mastercard Debit and Prepaid – \$0.05 + 1.25% of the payment amount
- Mastercard Credit (and other Mastercard card types) – \$0.05 + 1% of the payment amount
- PayPal – \$0.07 + 0.9% of the payment amount

In order to minimise the impact of the surcharges, we would encourage regular users of Flexischools using these payment methods to consider topping up their account and/or setting up automatic top-ups rather than paying separately for individual transactions.
