INTERSCHOOL CROSS COUNTRY 2021 - WEDNESDAY 5TH MAY



All Grade 3-5 students have been invited to compete in the Divisional Cross Country on Wednesday 5th of May at the Bendigo Racecourse. We encourage the top 10 (Boys/Girls) students from the Holy Rosary Cross Country to attend and it is optional for all other students. You will only need to give consent on PAM if your child is racing. If they choose not to race, they will stay at school and complete normal school work.
