## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

The term is off to a fantastic start with only minimal disruptions. We will continue to provide updates on positive COVID cases within the school, as per the government and CES directives. All reports are made to families immediately after we are informed. Today further RAT tests were sent home with children who are onsite and we appreciate the efforts families are making to test twice a week supporting the safety of everyone.

A reminder that parents are allowed onsite for short amounts of time, however not in the classroom at this stage, which is part of our COVIDSafe plans and the operations guidelines.

Our Grade 4-6 children have headed to Bendigo East pool today for trials, prior to the Catholic Swimming sports on February 28<sup>th</sup>. We are really excited to be able to continue to participate in a safe manner, thanks to Mr Coates and Mrs Taylor for the huge amount of work undertaken to ensure the children can participate.

Our final day for Learning Conversations will be Wednesday this week and I encourage families to make a booking if they haven't already. We had an outstanding number of families join the conversation with their children's teachers last week and look forward to continuing as such this week.

All staff have a professional learning day on Thursday and will be focussing on the development of literacy across the school. This will be a pupil free day for everyone.

A reminder that the tennis courts are a drive through, we ask that parents and caregivers remain in their car. We are conscious of the need to keep traffic flowing both morning and afternoon.

Lastly, we have a call out for helpers at the Marong cup. If you can spare an hour or two, we would really appreciate your help collecting glasses in the members area. The Marong Cup is a great fundraising support to our school over many years and we have funded playgrounds, pastoral care support, sports equipment and many other aspects of school with the funds raised. It is a great fun day out and it would also be great to see families come along for the day out.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE - CAMPS, SPORTS AND EXCURSION FUND (CSEF)

The Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) is a Victorian Government program that assists eligible families to cover the cost of school trips, camps and sporting activities. ## CHILDREN'S CHATTER MATTERS



*In order to prepare for the language & learning demands of the school environment, children need ample time and opportunity to engage in meaningful interactions with their family.*

### TERM 1: PHONOLOGICAL AWARENESS

**Focus: Developing phonological and phonemic awareness skills, i.e.; the ability to recognise sounds and sound patterns as they occur in words.**

### 2. Rhyme Awareness

Rhyme awareness is another early phonological awareness skill which builds emergent literacy skills. Rhyming requires children to listen closely for sounds within words. Children who recognise rhyme realise that words are made up of separate parts. Rhyming words are words which have the same ending sound, regardless of spelling.





10. When you have completed orders for all children (and added a family photo if required), click 'View Cart' to review your order.
11. Select 'Checkout' to complete your order & pay.
