PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

This week we host our Term 3 Learning Conversations. As a school we believe wholeheartedly in the power of a strong parent-teacher partnership. We value open communication and encourage parents to actively participate in their child's education. As such our upcoming conversations will provide an excellent opportunity to discuss progress, address concerns and collaborate for the benefit of our students. As a key pillar in our assessment and reporting program I urge all families to endeavour to make an appointment during this time.

Sunday's Gospel, "The Parable of the Sower," is much more about the seed, than the farmer. Although there will be obstacles to telling others the Good News, the message will be received by many. Some of the sower's seeds fell on rocky ground, on paths where people walked and among thorns. While these seeds probably won't take, the seed that fell on good soil has the chance of reaping a tremendous harvest.

We meet many obstacles and sometimes feel our children simply don't hear us. But the seed that falls on good soil (and our children are good soil) will produce an enormous yield. We need only not to be discouraged, nor give up in the face of obstacles.



Our return to school means a change in traffic conditions around the school. It is great to see families using the drive through, remembering to remain in your car and making a lap if the children aren't ready. However, we have been advised by council that parking around the school needs to consider local laws and I have been informed that spot checks will be taking place.

In addition, it is extremely UNSAFE to have children running to get into a car that is in the middle of the road. Please park for pick up or use the drive through, understanding we are busy and safety remains paramount.

Finally, it was great to see the new beanies arrive and being distributed. As an addition to the uniform, they look great and certainly keep heads and ears warm during this very cold weather. Importantly, we ask that children wear the correct winter uniform. Wearing Holy Rosary's uniform is a badge of pride, creates an identity for our school and is an important part of being part of our community. A Holy Rosary uniform shows that you are part of our school. Wearing it says we're all in this together. Also, when you wear your uniform with pride, it reflects the pride you have in not only your school, but in yourself.



The carnival is a fantastic day for all of our students to participate in a range of sporting events to the best of their ability. Please feel free to come and support our school and our kids!


Some Important Information:

- PARENT HELPERS NEEDED We are in need of about 10-12 parent helpers for our athletics day. Duties mostly include
 measurement and recording. If you are able to help, please let Troy or the office know. All volunteers will need to have a
 valid WCC (or exemption) and have completed their Volunteer Application and Child Safety Code of Conduct documents.
- Your child is asked to wear their **house colours** for the day. If you are unsure of what your child's colour is, please see your classroom teacher.
- Students need to bring a hat, water bottle and food for the day.
- Our school canteen (lunch orders) will operate on Thursday 27th, in lieu of Friday. There will no canteen available on Athletics day

The next level is the **Catholic Schools Athletics Carnival**, which will be held on Wednesday 16th August at the Flora Hill Athletics Track. Students in Grades 3 to 6 will be notified if they make this event. Please note that 9yr old students can only make it through in shot put, long jump, hurdles and 100m. Should they qualify for more than 3, they will have to choose their preferred events and then the spot is offered to the next highest finishing student. Thank you for your ongoing support!


How Can We Help?
