# PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

This Saturday we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, a special day for our parish and school. As we celebrate this feast, we are reminded of the power of prayer and faith. The rosary, a form of meditative prayer, becomes a profound symbol of hope and spiritual strength. It teaches us the importance of turning to Mary, the Mother of Jesus, for guidance, protection, and intercession.

In our fast-paced lives, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary encourages us to pause, reflect, and engage in contemplative prayer. It invites us to ponder the mysteries of the rosary, which are reflections on the key moments in the lives of Jesus Christ and Mary. Through these mysteries, we find inspiration, solace, and courage to face life's challenges with faith and fortitude. Today we have focussed on the significance of the day, attended a whole school Mass and participated in activities to further mark the day's importance for our community.

It was great to have the Federal Member for Bendigo, Lisa Chesters, visit Holy Rosary yesterday. She was able to inspect the sustainability block and our STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) learning area, which had been refurbished using much-needed Federal funding.

During her tour of the funded areas, Lisa Chesters had the opportunity to engage with year 6 students, who impressed her with their informed and insightful questions. She encouraged the young minds to share their thoughts and ideas on how they would contribute to their community if they were the Federal Member. The students did not disappoint, offering a range of thoughtful suggestions, showcasing their civic awareness and enthusiasm for positive change.

One notable commitment that Lisa Chesters made during her visit was her pledge to return to Holy Rosary Catholic Primary School next year to speak with students. This return visit will coincide with the schools unit on politics, providing students with a unique opportunity to learn firsthand from their Federal Member about the workings of government.

Earlier in the week all families received an email inviting you to complete a short survey about our school. Firstly a big thank you to those who have already completed the task, it is great to have feedback upon which we can reflect. It would be really good to have some more participants, and I ask if you have a small amount of time to do so it would be greatly appreciated.

A reminder that we have our learning conversations on Monday, a very important part of our assessment and reporting program. The opportunity to discuss progress, set and review goals and provide feedback is central to building a positive relationship between families and our teachers. We look forward to seeing everyone either online or in person.


### **SCHOOL RUN 4 FUN: COLOUR EXPLOSION**

Big prizes are up for grabs! With awesome prizes available for anyone who raises as little as \$10!






# How Can We Help?
