## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

It was great to see so many visitors at school to celebrate the Feast of our Lady of the Rosary. A big thanks to the staff and students who were so welcoming and proud to share their classrooms. We can never underestimate the power of significant adults in the lives of our children and the engagement was certainly a pleasure to see.

This week we celebrate the episcopal ordination of the next Bishop of Sandhurst, Fr Shane Mackinlay. Bishop elect Mackinlay comes from Ballarat where he is a parish Priest. We look forward to welcoming our new Bishop to Holy Rosary in the coming months. Mrs Carter and I will be attending the ceremony on behalf of the school at the Cathedral. This is an exciting time for our Diocese and we also give thanks for the service of Bishop Les Tomlinson who moves into retirement having served in the role since 2009.

In Sunday's Gospel, Jesus healed ten lepers, but only one (an unlikely one, at that!) came back to thank Jesus and give praise to God. Jesus wondered where the others were and why they didn't think to praise God for their healing.

In reflecting on this story, it's unlikely that the lepers in today's Gospel weren't happy about being healed from a dreaded disease that isolated them from their family and friends. However, they never said thank you to Jesus. Maybe they were too busy, too excited, too preoccupied, or too thoughtless.

As parents, we have certainly experienced a lack of gratitude from our children. We know they are truly grateful for their home, the food they eat, the bed they sleep in, the clothes they wear, the taxi service we provide and the hours we spend playing with them. But most kids are not often there with a big hug and "Thank You!" Yet, our love does not diminish in the carelessness of our children, just as God's healing did not disappear from the lepers. Likewise, even though we forget to thank God and praise him for all our rich blessings, healings, and mercy, the gift of love keeps coming, just as our love continues for our children.



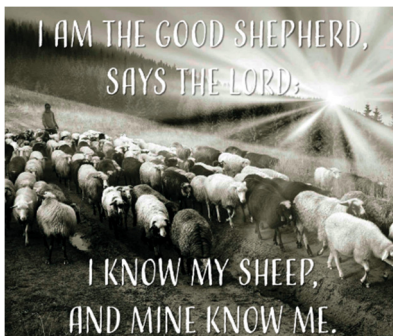
Finally, if you are leaving Holy Rosary for any reason, at the end of the year please let me know as soon as possible to support our planning.

# FREE DENTAL SCREENING

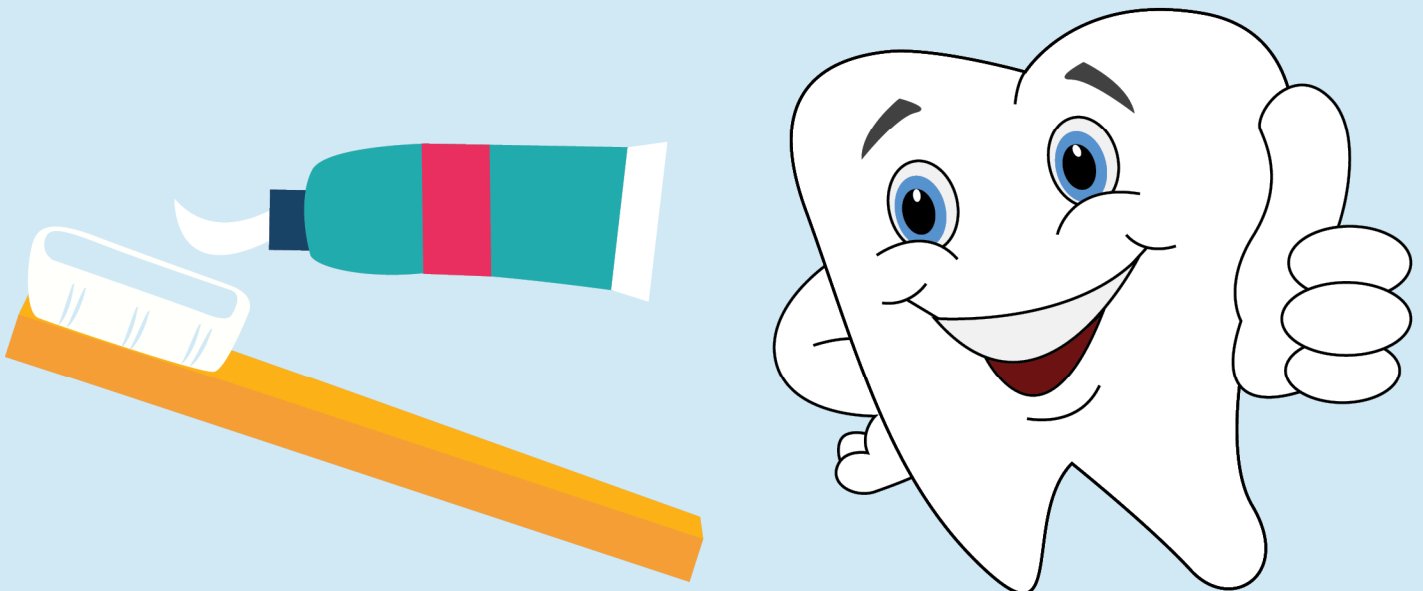
'The oral health of your children is important to us'
