As we move into the warmer weather please ensure that jumpers are labelled as well as hats, they all look the same and are beginning to mount up in the lost property area. Also if children are not in uniform please write a note to their classroom teacher, we are again beginning to have some substitutions for uniform.

From time to time our children live in a "me first world," but Jesus wasn't too impressed with the self-centeredness of the Pharisee in Sunday's Gospel. The Pharisee was quite certain that he was a good and righteous man—better than most. For sure, he was better than the tax collector. But as Jesus often did in his teachings, he turned society's ideas upside down. It was really the humble tax collector recognizing his own sinfulness that Jesus said would be exalted.

As parents we are very important in the lives of our children, but do we allow them to see us walk humbly with God? Do we allow them to see us on our knees and hear us admit our weaknesses to God? Consider how you might represent the tax collector to your children. How might they see you like this Pharisee?

This Friday we celebrate All Saints day which will also provide for our annual memorial day liturgy. The children in Grade 3-6 will participate in our Memorial Day Liturgy at 10.30am in the church. This is a time when we remember those who have died, especially those named in our memorial garden. For adults in attendance there will be a cup of tea in the back area of the church (Narthex).

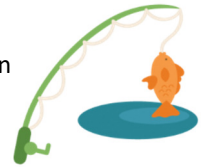

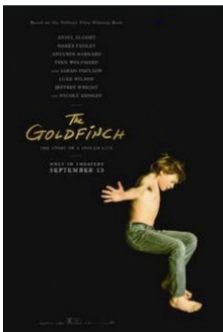
