# PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Welcome back to everyone for Term 4! It's hard to believe we are entering the last quarter of the year having had such a tumultuous year. We are very pleased to know with some certainty that we have a plan to return to school albeit a staggered return.

Today and for the rest of the week we welcome back all of our Foundation - Grade 2 children. Our Grade 3 - 6 children will continue with remote learning.

Next week, and for the following week (Week 2 & 3), Foundation - Grade 2 children remain full time at school and in a staggered approach;

\*Grades 3-4 will attend school on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, Remote learning Monday, Thursday, Friday.

\*Grades 5-6 will attend on Thursdays and Fridays. Remote learning Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday

Finally from Tuesday 26 October (Week 4), all students will be back in the classroom full-time. We will also have a public holiday on the 27th October for Bendigo Cup Day just to keep life interesting.

Unfortunately, only essential visitors are allowed on site. This means parents will not be allowed on site for morning drop off or afternoon pick up.

Should you need to collect a child early please check in via QR code and report directly to the school office.

For all other enquiries, please call the office on arrival.

Canteen and Uniform shop are both back from this Friday, and volunteers are able to be on site, but must check in using the QR code and be vaccinated. Please contact me if you require any further clarification.

We have many things planned for this term including transition, graduation and other activities. At this stage we are working hard to plan a way forward and how these may look as we steadily come back to some sort of normality. We will keep you informed as soon as we know what is permitted.

Our building project continues to gather momentum with demolition works taking place this week. We look forward to seeing things happen over the coming weeks after such a long wait. Again, as milestones approach we will keep everyone up to date. This week will see the demolition begin which will be exciting for everyone here.



SPF 50+ sunscreen will also be available to children in each classroom. Children will be responsible for applying their own sunscreen.


